Directions to Allegawaho Park: Travel East on East Main Street to 5th Street, turn right. Follow blacktop road (Dunlap road) 3 1/2 miles to X Avenue, turn left, Travel about 1/2 mile, turn left on 525 Rd. The arbor will be on your left in about 1/2 mile. There is parking in a lot beside the road, as well as on the road. Watch for signs.

Please bring your own lawn chair. There will be a short distance to walk to the arbor.

Powwow etiquette:

The area beneath the arbor is used for dancing and ceremonies and is called the arena. For the Kaw people, the arena is a sacred place. The ground has been blessed by the Kaw spiritual leaders. Photographs may be taken during the Powwow, but please ask permission before taking photos of individuals. This is all part of our powwow etiquette.
